CIC Legislative Committee 2005

Steering

- SB 98 --- California -- would create steering friendly insurance policies.
Status: Amended to delete this section.
- HF 1528 --- Minnesota --- Insurer must cease all efforts to influence choice after insured has made decision.
Status: Passed. Effective 8-1-05
- SB 388 --- Montana --- Requires insurers to admit any qualified shop into their DRP, thus reducing steering.
Status: Passed. Effective 10-1-05



CIC Legislative Committee 2005

Steering

- SB 513 - South Carolina --- Anti - Steering Legislation
Status: Passed Subcommittee. Legislature reconvenes in January, 06'.

- HB 2330 - Illinois ---- Anti-steering bill to require insurer's to inform insured's they are prohibited from requiring repairs done at specific facilities and they are entitled to select their own shop.

Status : Pending

HB 2468 -- Arizona ---- Insurers must notify insured's of right to select repair facility of their choice.

Status: Current law.
