What is it?




It seems to be the direct buying of parts by an insurance company or the specification by an insurance company of what type of part to purchase and from which supplier it should be bought.

- Palm Springs planning meeting
- Air bag proposal in Minnesota
- SCRS Aftermarket Parts Study
- Concern by collision repairers



- Concern by collision repairers
 - ◆Business interference
 - Longstanding vendor relationships
 - ♦ Will parts go the way of glass?
 - ◆If parts profitability is lost, then labor profitability needs to double



- **◆**False economies
 - •3rd party delays process
 - Cycle time concerns
 - What are the hidden expenses?
- ◆No formal feedback or complaint system



- Insurance Companies' Perspectives
 - ◆ <u>Always</u> looking at cycle time and cost savings initiatives
 - ◆ Efficiencies are being sought
 - Very sensitive issue, especially direct parts purchasing
 - ◆ There <u>will be</u> future parts procurement programs



- Parts suppliers are selected locally
- Credible suppliers are sought
- Always seeking a balance between cost and cycle time
 - ◆ Right part
 - ◆ Right price
 - ◆ Right time
- A real desire to get this balance right



- Parts Suppliers' Viewpoints
 - ◆ Insurance companies are "over involved"
 - ◆ A need for measurable and verifiable data
 - ◆ Database criteria: suppliers have qualities that go beyond parts data and price
 - Compliancy reinspections should be done to ensure that the shops actually use the specified parts



- The Role of the Database Providers:
 - ◆ Instant access to timely and accurate parts supplier & part choices
 - ◆ Provide all the available parts sources the market or customers wish to access
 - ◆ Fully customized database:
 - For each collision repair scenario
 - To reach specific alternative part utilization goals



- Mitchell Alternative Parts ProgramTM
 - ◆ MAPP
 - ◆ Supports
 - OEM discounted parts
 - Aftermarket new parts
 - CAPA & MQVP
- Mitchell Quality Recycled PartsTM (QRP)
 - Supports recycled parts



- MAPP/QRP are open systems
- No cost to suppliers or data sources if defined format and standards are met
- MAPP requirements:
 - ◆ Specific data formats
 - ◆ Quality levels must be met
 - ◆ Timely updates



- MAPP requirements continued
 - ◆ Accurate (and honored) parts pricing
 - ◆ Inclusive of delivery
 - ♦ Warranties
 - ◆ Parts availability/sufficient inventory



- QRP requirements
 - ◆ Recyclers adhere to industry standards of performance
 - ◆ Automotive Recyclers Association Recycled Parts Guide Standards
 - ◆ As adopted by the ARA & URG



- Mitchell also supports special supplier programs for specific estimating clients
 - ◆ May include special service level agreements specific to:
 - A parts supplier
 - An estimating solution client
 - ◆ Client-specific performance agreements may be included
 - Supplier participation fees may be included
