Parts Procurement Europe: Background

Progressive legislation within EU seeking to increase competition

Insurance


Directives 1 - 4, Directive 5 on the way

More Choice



Latest position

- Vehicle Assemblers oppose changes to BER through Design Protection Clause
- E-CAR counter with Repair Clause
- Brussels appoint Thatcham to conduct tests on panels, Autopolis to produce report
- Separate report from London Consulting confirms 'captive' parts price premium
- Thatcham/Autopolis report to Legal Affairs Committee



UK Market

- Open and free
- High level of full Casco / fully comprehensive insurance
- High level of directed repairs
- Mature Approved Repair Networks
- Overall bodyshop numbers declining
- Repair complexity increasing




UK Procurement Practice

- Usually three parties involved, can include motor manufacturers.
- Parts selected against quality, availability and price/margin criteria.
- Rules applied differently to different marques & models and age of vehicle.
- Often parts used are of OEM or accredited quality to overcome perceived problems of quality & fit.



AudaSource Components



- 3 components used singularly or in combination
- Specifically designed to meet the needs of the Crash Repair sector.
- The benefits derived are on going, sustainable, and optimise repair costs for adopters.





AudaSource: Examples of rules

- By make and model: Treat Mercedes & BMW one way & Ford, GM another
- By age of vehicle: Treat vehicles up to 7 years old one way over 7 another
- By Quality of part: On vehicles >3yrs use OE or OEM; on vehicles <3yrs use accredited or warranted parts; on 'veterans' >10yrs use general pattern parts
- By common sense: Use OE where cheaper than AM part
- By availability: Only use part if in stock & available (say within three days)



Procurement models Norwich Union

- First insurer to move into parts procurement, with the 'Unity' Program
- Intention to source OE and AM parts
- Initial JV partner Lex Automotive
- VAs wouldn't co-operate fully, though BMW & Ford did a deal
- Now using Unipart SSVG
- Elective system





Procurement models: Allianz Cornhill

- Are using substitution only
- Have partnered with SEL Imperial
- System is mandatory, purchase of parts elective
- Allianz will only pay shop the value of the SEL part, as it appears on the estimate



AudaSource Allianz Workflow







Estimate data sent to supplier with availability / delivery details





Bodyshop fits, pays for parts, invoices Insurance company directly



Supplier delivers and invoices parts to Bodyshop



Parts ordered by bodyshop directly on supplier (not IAS)



Estimate Xref parts data, repairer price, availability & delivery offer made by supplier to bodyshop by fax/ email






Procurement models: RBS

- Includes Direct Line & Churchill brands
- Works across the ARN with one supplier Unipart SSVG.
- A very tight process requiring SLA performance from bodyshop and SSVG
- Covers returns and credits

Trader. Trader holds prices etc &

sends offer details to bodyshop



Procurement models: RSA

- Operate labour only scheme, rate inflated to offset loss of parts margin
- Parts are purchased by bodyshop and invoiced to RSA at cost
- Some shops 'solus' to RSA



Procurement models: S America

- Parts often identified, ordered and paid for by insurance company
- Main concern is supply chain corruption
- Bodyshops receive parts from supplier,
 acknowledge receipt, insurer pays supplier
- Insurers using this method include: GNP, ING,
 Qualitas & Inbursa



Procurement models: Poland

- Poland / East Europe
- Common practice is for insurers to inspect damaged vehicles at local offices, raise an estimate and pay cash to the vehicle owner.
- Alternate parts (usually OEM quality) used in the estimate to reduce value of pay out.
- Large number of repeat claims!





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Benefits: Repairers

- No additional effort required from Repairer.
- Full compliance with insurer rules ensures prompt settlement and payment.
- Parts routed to the preferred supplier /distributor maintains valued relationships.
- Protects existing retail prices stabilizes margins.
- Profit margin protection ensures usage of AM parts does not erode profit
- Incorporates stock availability optimizes repair and cycle time management.
- Can save 1 to 2 hours parts admin per job (depending on initial efficiency).





Conclusions

- Pressure on insurance companies to reduce costs (combined ratios over 100)
- Legislation forcing further market openness
- Unlikely that current objections from VAs will halt this momentum
- AM parts range increasing & quality improving
- Captive parts currently attract a premium
- Now known that the EU commissioned report concluded AM parts are not inferior
- Some VAs embracing the new world others resistant
- Likely that VAs will approach the insurers table with incentives



Summary & Conclusions

- Experience in the UK and elsewhere suggests AM parts can be used satisfactorily
- No noticeable adverse reaction from vehicle owners
- Repairers can influence choice of parts and margins earned.
- Insurers will become emboldened to spread the practice



Summary & Conclusions

- The European Crash Repair market is maturing rapidly
- New ways of doing business are needed & are evolving
- Procurement is inevitably going to play an important role
- This does not automatically mean to the detriment of shops or Supply Chain
- But if you aren't involved you can't influence the outcome!
